



FOSTER TO ADOPT IN OHIO

CONTACT

Your family contacts the local Necco office about becoming a foster parent. An orientation, paperwork and background checks will follow.



TRAINING

2

The Necco team gets a sense of what types of children the family is most equipped, interested and willing to work with.

3

HOME STUDY

The home study portion gives Necco a better idea of your families' background, experience, motives, history and recommendations.



APPROVAL

4

After completion of assessments, training and the home study, your family will be notified of approval.

5

RESIDENCY

If the child becomes eligible for adoption through the court system and the child has resided in your home for 6 months, your family will become eligible to finalize the adoption.



ADOPTION

6

After six months in a foster home, the court issues a decree of adoption. Your relationship as parent and child is permanently and legally established.
